## Ten Realities About The Word of God Psalm 19:7-11

1. <u>The Law of the Lord</u> is perfect, restoring the Soul-God's Word has no defect and has the ability to bring one back to God; bringing genuine life to the person.

**Point to Consider**: It is God working through His word that changes lives not man and his wisdom.

2. <u>The Testimony of the Lord</u> is sure, making wise the simple- God's Word is true, reliable, stable, and trustworthy and is able give people skill in living life properly in all aspects resulting in one being stable, steady, and restrained from acting in an evil manner.

**Point to Consider:** God's Word has the ability to lead you from being naïve and gullible to being skilled in living a life that will benefit you now and benefit you for eternity as oppose to man's insights that will lead you to a life of confusion, disorder and every evil thing now and to eternity of damnation later.

3. <u>The Precepts of the Lord</u> is right rejoicing the heart- God's Word is straight or correct, it lines up with the character of God leading one to have a cheerful countenance, experiencing gladness, or happiness of soul when applied properly.

**Point to Consider:** God's Word can lead you to experiencing a soul that has joy apart from people and circumstances going your way as you apply God's word His way.

4. <u>The Commandment of the Lord</u> is pure, enlightening the eyes- God's Word is "spotless, clean, without fault" and able to give people understanding to walk in a path of life that is pleasing to God.

**Point to Consider**: God uses His Word to give you clarity to the path of life that is intended for you to walk in whereas man's wisdom brings confusion keeping you in darkness.

5. <u>The Fear of the Lord</u> is clean, enduring forever- God's Word is free from moral impurity and will last forever.

**Point to Consider:** God's Word will always be around whereas pop psychologies and theories will fade away; You will be wise to adhere to the Word of God instead of the fleeting counsel of the pop psychologist and theorist of this age for God's Word will stand the test of time.

6. *The Judgments of the Lord* are true-God's word is reality thus never being false.

**Point to Consider**: God's Word is always true, therefore it will never lie to us or change according to the latest whims and ways of the popular culture.

7. <u>The Judgments of the Lord</u> are righteous altogether- God's word is appropriate, it is not tied to injustice

**Point to Consider**: God's Word gives the ability to understand what is appropriate and right universally above what any culture, race, political party, poll, or survey may deem is appropriate and right.

8. <u>God's Word</u> is more desirable than gold, fine gold, and sweeter than honey and a honeycomb - God's word is the most valuable commodity one could have and sweeter to the taste above anything one can taste.

**Point to Consider**: God's word should be treasured above anything in this life we deem valuable or tasty.

9. <u>God's Word</u> warns the servant of the Lord- God's word gives insight of dangers to come in relation to walking in sin.

**Point to Consider**: God's Word can keep you from avoidable dangers if you would take heed to its' warnings; Many of the painful consequences you are encountering now are because you would not take heed to God's warning from His Word.

10. <u>God's Word</u> brings great reward to the servant that obeys them-God's word will be a benefit in many ways to the one that will follow it accordingly.

**<u>Point to Consider:</u>** God's Word applied God's way will bring great benefits to your life.
