Knowing and Embracing The Spiritual Stages of Development

Key Point: If we are going to maximize our life for Christ, we must know and embrace the spiritual stages of development.

(1 John 2:12-14)

Stage One of Spiritual Development: A *child* knows he is a child of God and is forgiven of His sin, but has not yet developed in overcoming the evil one and abiding in the Word of God.¹

Stage Two of Spiritual Development: <u>A young man</u> is one who is strong in the faith, overcoming the evil one and his opposition, and abiding in the word of God.²

Stage Three of Spiritual Development <u>A *Father*</u> is one who has a deep personal knowing of God beyond intellectual insight; along with being strong in the faith, overcoming evil one, overcoming opposition, and abiding in the word of God.³

We can move through the major stages as we learn and practice:

A. The *Distinctive* Elements We are to grow in:

- 1. We are to develop in godly thinking patterns and motives (Romans 12:2).
- 2. We are to develop in godly desires (Matthew 6:19-22, Colossians 3:1-5).
- 3. We are to develop in godly communication patterns (Ephesians 4:29).
- 4. We are to develop in godly behavioral patterns (Ephesians 4:17-32).
- 5. We are to develop in godly relational patterns (Colossians 3:12-14).
- 6. We are to develop in godly serving patterns (John 13:1-17).

B. The *Determined* Steps We are to take:

- 1. <u>Realization</u> We must come to see truth and understand how it applies to our lives (2Timothy 2:24-26).
- 2. <u>Remorse</u> We must come to feel godly sorrow in relation to our sin and desire to make things right with God and others accordingly.(2 Corinthians 7:10).
- 3. <u>Renounce</u> We must come to confess our sin to God and to others when appropriate (Psalm 32:1-11, James 5:16).
- 4. <u>Repentance</u>— We must come to turn away from our sin towards God and towards others accordingly (Proverbs 28:13, 2Corinthians 7:10-11).
- 5. <u>Renewal</u> We must come to meditate on the truth so that we may learn the new direction by which we are to obey God and love others accordingly (Ephesians 4:17-23).
- 6. <u>Replacement</u> We must comes to obey God and love others in the areas where he has disobeyed God and been unloving towards others (Ephesians 4:17-23).

C. The *Devoted* Life We are to have:

- 1. <u>Membership</u> We should be devoted to a local church so that we may experience love and enjoy the blessings of God-honoring relationships.(Hebrews 10:19-24)
- 2. <u>Maturity</u> We should be devoted to discipleship in a local Church that would lead us into loving God, loving others on a consistent basis and living a life that reflects the character of Christ. (2Timothy 2:15-22)
- 3. <u>Magnification</u> We should be devoted to appreciating, valuing and adoring the character of God through heart-felt genuine worship of Him in a local Church. (John 4:23-24)
- 4. <u>Ministry</u> We should be devoted to serving in a ministry where we can develop in bearing burdens and meeting needs according to the various relationships we will develop through the local Church. (1Peter 4:10-11)
- 5. <u>Missions</u> We should be devoted to working with and supporting the Church in sharing and defending the Christian faith. (2 Corinthians 5:15-21, 1Peter 3:15)
